

Administration Webinar for Projektron BCS

The webinar provides a brief overview of the administration and monitoring possibilities in the Projektron BCS administration area and configuration using the WebConfig editor.

You will learn how to make preferences available to all users, use rights settings to limit the visibility of views, look at the license consumption of the current day, add a new logo to quotation and invoice letterheads, show attributes on a view and redefine labels. After the webinar, you will be provided with a handout summarizing the explained points.

We will then be available to explain and answer your questions on the topic during the two-hour session.
